Certificate III in Wall and Ceiling Lining

Course Overview:

This is a trade qualification for wall and ceiling linings in residential and commercial construction workplaces. It includes applying and fixing linings to non-structural walls and ceilings, as well as working with fibrous plastering materials. Occupational titles may include:

Drywaller

Wall and Ceiling Liner

Plasterer

State and territory jurisdictions may have different licensing, legislative, regulatory, or certification requirements. Relevant state and territory regulatory authorities should be consulted to confirm those requirements.

Completion of the general construction induction training program, specified in the Safe Work Australia model Code of Practice: Construction Work, is required by anyone carrying out construction work. Achievement of **CPCWHS1001 – Prepare to work safely in the construction industry** meets this requirement. The achievement of this unit is embedded within the course structure, ensuring students are industry-compliant from day one.

This qualification provides the skills and knowledge to potentially gain employment as a:

Certificate III in Wall and Ceiling Lining (CPC31220) allows direct entry into this qualification at the time of publication in training.gov.au.

However, the RTO requires candidates to meet its admission requirements prior to enrolling into this qualification to ensure that they have the required skills and knowledge to successfully complete the qualification at this AQF level. This consists of:

Course Entry Requirements: Applicants must be at least 18 years old.

Academic Requirement: Completion of Year 12 VCE or equivalent overseas qualifications. Additionally, having a strong interest in the building and construction industry and possessing adequate literacy and numeracy skills are important.

Additional Requirement: Northwood International College (NIC) conducts a Language, Literacy, Numeracy and Digital Literacy (LLND) assessment during orientation to gauge each student's skill levels and determine the level of support needed for timely completion of the qualification; this assessment is diagnostic only and does not restrict course entry. Additionally, students must obtain a construction induction (white) card before undertaking any site visits. Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is required when visiting a construction site. (Steel cap boots, Hard hat, High Vis and Glasses).

Mode of Delivery: This course will be delivered as classroom-based face-to-face training.
